SECTION 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Eye Contact: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Do not rub eyes and seek medical advice if irritation develops or persists. Do not forcibly remove cured products.

SECTION 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES
